

## Assesment

1. Teaching the vocabularies using flashcard  
During the class, I would assess my students using flashcards after watching a video and singing along with the song that I had played beforehand. This assessment is done to know how much vocabulary that they would have recognized after watching the music video. It requires me as a teacher to observe the way students answer or parroting the word in the flashcard. This is related to students' listening and speaking skills
2. "how do I feel when..?"  
This question is asked during the class after teaching them the vocabulary to see how far students understood the word and in what situation they express certain feelings or emotions. In addition, I could see how confident they are in expressing their emotions using English.
3. Watching a music video  
This activity is used to observe how well students can imitate something and learn the vocabulary by watching the video we played. This activity needs a lot of energy to show how cheerful and excited we are so that the students will also be excited with the activity and would not get bored even though the music video will be played twice.
4. Games: matching the words, missing fc, and whisper game.  
My purpose to conduct such activity is to engage them in learning and ask them to actively participate in class. Using games would make them feel like playing while in fact they are learning and in the middle of being assessed by me as the teacher.
