Learning Objectives	Students are able to tell the time to the hour and half on an analog clock
Target Vocabulary	Clock, o'clock, time

Learning Procedures	
Warm-Up	1. Greeting Teacher greets the students by saying “Hello my

	<p>students! Good morning, how are you today? Are you happy or sad”, “I’m glad to know that you are fine and happy”</p> <p>2. Praying Teacher leads the students to pray together by saying “Before we start our lesson, let’s pray together”</p> <p>3. Checking attendance Teacher calls students’ names one by one and asks “Who’s absent today?”</p> <p>4. Reviewing previous lesson Teacher gives a short flashback by saying “Yesterday, we learned about numbers. Now we are going to learn about something new but it’s kind of related to numbers. Are you excited?”</p>
Main Activity	<p>1. Watching “Telling Time 1” song video and sing together Teacher plays song video about Telling Time for the introduction to the lesson</p> <p>2. Discussing about what they have noticed from the video Teacher asks the students “What do you think about the video?”, “Do you notice something from the video?”, “What is the video about?” and so on. Then, teacher explains the learning objectives of this lesson</p> <p>3. Introducing clock and review numbers 1 to 12 Teacher explains first about the types of clocks and the parts of a clock. Students learn that clocks are a tool used to measure time. Teacher reviews again about numbers.</p> <p>4. Making clock together Teacher asks students to make small groups. Teacher gives each group their own analog clock craft without numbers on it so that they can write it by themselves. Students also asked to attach the hands on the clock.</p> <p>5. Teaching and practicing the time to the hour vocabularies Teacher teaches students how to tell the time to the hour</p> <p>6. Guessing time with analog clock Teacher gives students a mini quiz by providing the clock and asks “Please could you tell me the time?” “What time is it?”</p>

	<p>7. Watching “Telling Time 2” song video and sing together Teacher plays the “Telling Time 2” video about time to the half hour</p> <p>8. Introducing time to the half hour Teacher explains to the students about half hour</p> <p>9. Teaching and practicing the time to the half hour vocabularies Teacher teaches students how to tell the time to the half hour</p> <p>10. Guessing time with analog clock Teacher gives students a mini quiz by providing the clock and asks “Please could you tell me the time?” “What time is it?”</p>
Warp-Up	<p>1. Reviewing today’s lesson about time Teacher ask students what they have learned today then explains the material briefly</p> <p>2. Giving homework Teacher distributes homework worksheets to the students. Teacher explains the instructions first so that they know what to do.</p> <p>3. Saying goodbye Teacher ends the class by saying “Goodbye students, see you on the next meeting”</p>
