LESSON PLAN ON TEACHING SEASONS
FOR YOUNG LEARNERS

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A. Program Identity

Month	June 2023	Topic	The Seasons

B. Topic Description

Every season comes with different celebrations! In this lesson, your students will learn about the seasons while exploring ways people celebrate events in each season. Students will also learn about the appropriate wardrobe for the different seasons.

C. Learning Objectives

Students are able to identify the characteristics of the five seasons and describe different events that happen in each.

D. Materials and Preparation

- Hello song

 - ▶ The Hello Song (Instrumental)
- Seasons Song
 - ▶ What's the Weather Like Today? (Instrumental)
- Printable worksheets
 - ★ Show and tell worksheet
 - ★ Drawing seasons worksheet
- Additional tools
 - ★ Pencils
 - ★ Crayons or colored pencils

E. Activities

WARM-UP procedure

1. Sing the "hello song"

Sit in a circle and sing along to the song. Encourage students to clap along or pat their laps in time with the music.

Lyrics for "The Hello Hello Song"

Hello, hello, how are you?

Hello, hello, how are you?

Hello, hello, how are you?

How are you today?

I am fine, I am great

I am fine, I am just great

I am fine, I am great

I am very well today

Great!

2. Welcoming & Greeting

Greet the students as they enter the classroom and introduce yourself to them. Then gesture for them to sit down.

MAIN ACTIVITY

1. Sing along to a fun season song.

Lyrics for "What's the Season"

What's the season,

What's the season,

What's the season like today?

All together

All together

What's the season like today?

Is it summer

Is it monsoon

Is it spring when flowering blooms

Is it winter

Is it autumn

What's the season like today

After that, tell the students what they will learn today.

2. Introducing the five seasons using a video animation

The teacher will introduce the names of all the five seasons and describe the events in each. The student will also learn about the appropriate wardrobe in each different season.

Ask your students if they like summer, rainy, winter, spring, or autumn seasons.

3. Fun games activity

a. Say the Act!

The teacher will show the pictures of the five kinds of seasons, and he/she will also do some actions that describe those seasons. Based on it, the students will say the season's name.

b. Show and Tell!

Same with the previous activity, the teacher will also show up pictures of the five kinds of seasons. The students will guess what we can do in that season.

c. Art Time!

The teacher will show her drawing on which season she likes the most. Based on the example, the students should draw his/her favorite season on the prepared worksheet.

WRAP-UP procedure

1. Invite your students to name all of the five seasons again. Ask for volunteers to explain why seasons change and how they affect people's moods, attitudes, or experiences.
